Slide 1 & 2: We've created three label options for you to choose from, and have translated those options into spanish as well. They are able to be printed in gray-scale if that is a more feasible options for you. They don't need margins, just print them as is, and cut along the black line to create each label strip. These labels can be printed onto regular paper and affixed to the pot (tape or glue or rubber band) or they can be printed onto sticker paper, whichever is easiest. If you like one of these labels the most and want it to be the only option, we can make a new slide with a triplicate of that option. :)

Slide 3 & 4: These are interactive labels for the pots that go home with the kids after classes. They're designed to be as low-cost and multi-use as possible. You will have to instruct the children to fill in the kind of plant they have as well as circle the care instructions on the label. It is designed in black and white to give children the opportunity to color it. The labels are intended to be printed as-is and cut along the solid black line. The dotted lines indicate folds. To make the label more compact, simply fold it accordion-style so that the farmer is facing the front.

Note: It is possible to print the Project Roots labels on one side and the plant label on the other to save paper.
