



HOW DOES NOISE AFFECT WILDLIFE?

DISRUPTS BIOLOGICAL PROCESSES

Noises like those from traffic can block out natural sounds animals rely on to survive, communicate and detect danger.

CAUSES BEHAVIORAL CHANGES

Unnatural sounds can cause wildlife to change their behavior, including abandoning their territory.

INTERRUPTS PLANT GROWTH

Human-generated noise has been shown to negatively affect plant growth. Vibrations from loud sounds can cause plant stress and deter essential pollinators.
